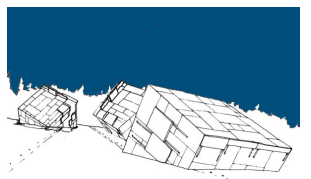
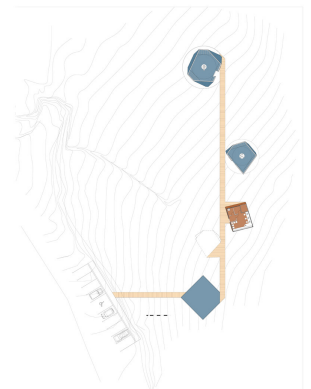
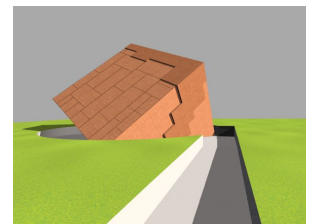
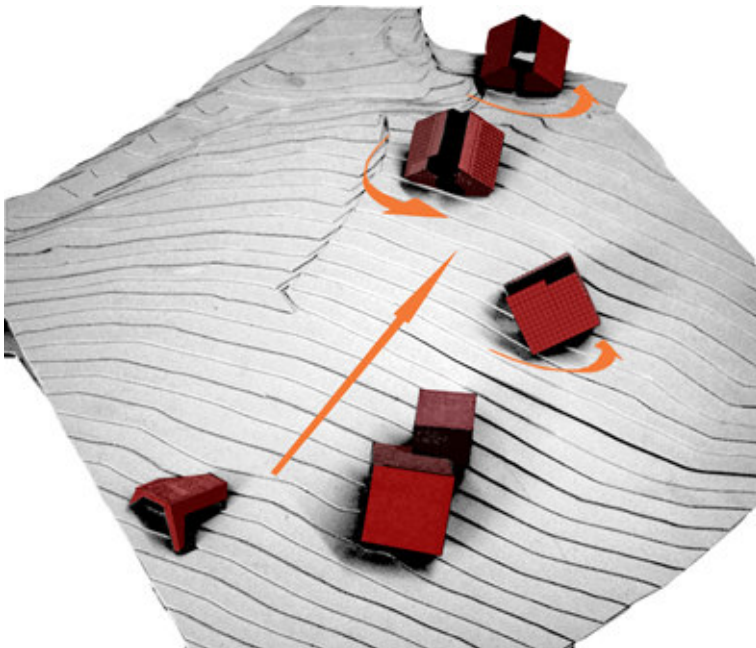


Kielder Observatory



Project: Competition entry for a new observatory located above the “Sky Space” at Kielder Water, Northumberland. The scheme used the concept of boxes dropped from the sky and tumbling down the hill. Each box contained a separate function, with telescopes housed in rotating, opening boxes to allow clear view of the whole of the sky. Units could be clad in a variety of materials and when closed would form a sculptural grouping.
