

# Scarborough Amphitheatre

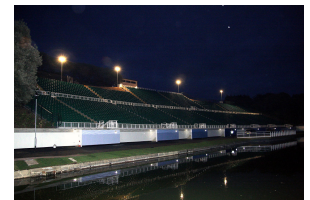
**Project:** The renovation of the 1930s built, Hodgson's Slack sited amphitheatre in Scarborough.

5,500 fixed seats were created with additional temporary seating available for special events. The work also included the refurbishment of ticketing and changing facilities, stage platform and landscaping, lighting and projection structures and new jetties and bridge link to the stage island. Accessibility issues were also addressed.

The amphitheatre had ceased to be used for performances in the mid 1980s, but is now running full summer season entertainment programs once again having been opened by the Queen on the 20<sup>th</sup> May 2010.
