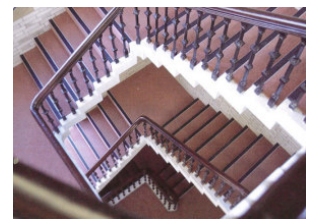
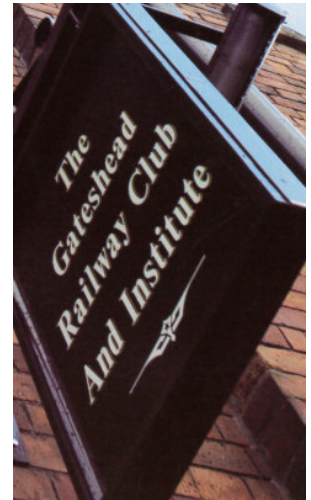


The Railway Club

The design and detail of new and refurbished building elements required extensive consultation with conservation officers, English Heritage and the Townscape Heritage Initiative.

Project: To transform a locally listed former Railway Club building into 48 private flats to the higher storeys and a separate club and function room for the Railway Club below. Careful consideration was needed to provide adequate sound insulation to the flats from the bar and the railway line running close by, whilst protecting the conservation heritage of the building.
