

# Summerhill Bowling Club



## Project:

Alterations to an existing early 20th C. bowling club in a conservation area in Newcastle upon Tyne to improve the internal environment which had fallen into disrepair over many years. The main hall was refurbished in a sensitive manner to create a modern light and flexible function space; the existing suspended ceiling was removed and the roof space opened up, the original timber floor was uncovered and restored, modern lights and a modern alarm system were also installed.

Increased levels of insulation and an improved heating system were added to create a comfortable and desirable function space designed to current building regulations. Existing washroom facilities were refurbished and repairs were made to the external envelope maintaining the character and appearance of the existing building within its surroundings.
